The set of expectations are in line with most, if not all, other medical schools' subinternship requirements.

**Please confirm that the following educational objectives of your course are consistent with the Warren Alpert Medical School of Brown University subinternship educational objectives:**

- Enhance the communication skills critical to high-quality patient care, including direct communication with patients and families, documentation skills, verbal and written communication with other physicians including sign out/patient handoffs, communication with non-physician team members, and participation in discharge planning.
- Advance their knowledge of disorders that are common in their chosen specialty.
- Develop patient management skills, including the ability to perform common procedures.
- Enhance growth mindset and evidence-based medicine skills essential to continued professional growth.

**Other Key Course Components:**

- There is a designated faculty member that assumes responsibility for evaluating the Warren Alpert Medical School sub-intern.
- This individual meets regularly with student throughout the subinternship (minimum weekly).
- Student will be functioning in an inpatient, outpatient, or hospital-based service role equivalent to that of a first-year trainee.
- Students are assigned a period of four weeks inpatient, outpatient, or hospital-based clinical care services where students have direct patient care responsibilities (i.e. not acting as a consultant).
- Meets all other requirements of subinternship at the away institution.
- Institution is affiliated with U.S. or Canadian medical school or is ACGME-accredited.
