**Part 1: Training**

Respiratory Protection Training for N95 use should include information such as the purpose for N95 use, limitations, inspections, how to put on and take off, when to replace, and how to perform a seal check. We will accept training delivered in either a classroom or online setting.

**Part 2: Fit-testing**

Fit-Testing must be done using 1 of the 4 masks listed below. We cannot accept masks of any other make/model. Exception: if student will be rotating at the Providence VA Medical Center, he/she must be fit-tested on one of the two 3M masks listed below.
